John 15:8-17



▶ In John 15:8-17, Jesus tells his disciples of the Father's love and commands them to "abide" in His love and to love others as He has loved us. Describe a time when someone acted lovingly toward you. What happened? How did it make you feel?

Read John 15:8-17

- 1. Jesus repeats "remain in me", "love", and "bear fruit". How are these words related? What is the "fruit that will last" (v. 16)?
- 2. What does it mean to "abide" in His love? How do we do this?
- 3. How do verses 9 and 12 tie together? How is love the essential dynamic of the Christian life? How does your relationship with Jesus change once you start practicing His example of love?
- 4. What is the link between obedience and prayer (vv. 7, 16, see 14:13-14)?



- As a branch on Christ's vine, how would you describe the fruit in your life? Why?
- Do you feel more like Jesus' servant or his friend? What helps develop the friendship?
- ▶ How would you rate yourself on loving others? What is one way you can allow God's love to pour through you onto others this week?
