Luke 18:18-34

how would you respond?

### Read Luke 18:18-34

- 1. What was Jesus getting at by questioning why the ruler called him a good teacher? What is his point in his response?
- 2. Which of the Ten Commandments does Jesus mention? Which does he leave out? Why do you think this is?
- 3. When the rich young ruler asked about eternal life, why do you think Jesus doesn't mention anything about faith or grace?
- 4. Since wealth was commonly considered a sign of God's blessing, what was the problem for the disciples (v. 26)?
- 5. What is the way into the kingdom (vv. 27-30)?
