# Sermon Guide

Luke 20:1-18



▶ How do you respond to authority? Which authority figures do you trust? Which do you distrust?

▶ What people, things, or events led you to recognize Jesus' authority?

Read [Luke 20:1-18](#)

1. What “things” (v. 2) has Jesus been doing? What about these things would worry the chief priests?
2. What interests are the religious leaders trying to protect from Jesus' question? Why does Jesus evade their question instead of answering them directly?
3. How does the parable of the wicked tenants relate to the question of authority raised in vv. 1-8?
4. What do the landowner, tenants, servants, and the son represent? Who do the “others” that the vineyard will be given to (v. 16) represent?
5. What does the quote in vv. 17-18 mean? What is a cornerstone? What is Jesus a cornerstone of? (See 1 Peter 2:4-7) How does this relate to the parable?

▶ Do you recognize God's authority over your life? How do you submit things like your money, job, family, free time, etc. over to God? What area of your life do you still need to surrender to God's authority?

▶ In what ways is Jesus the cornerstone of your life? In what ways is he not?

▶ Jesus continues to warn those who are rejecting him and invites them to repent. Who in your life is stumbling over Jesus and his death on the cross as the way to salvation? How can you pray for them?
