Luke 20:27-44



In Luke 20:27-39, the Sadducees ask Jesus a question about the resurrection. What one question would you like

to ask Jesus about life after death?

How do you deal with someone who wants to argue a point in the Bible? What if the person has honest questions and you don't know the answer?

Read Luke 20:27-44

- 1. Who questions Jesus in v. 27? What do they believe about the resurrection?
- 2. What was the "levirate marriage" referenced by the Sadducees? What was its purpose in Israelite society?
- 3. What does Jesus teach about life after death (vv. 34-36)?
- 4. How does Jesus "prove" the resurrection (see Exodus 3:6)?
- 5. What effect does Jesus' question about the son of David being David's Lord have? Of whom did he ask the question? Why?
