2. What does Jesus explain about the Scriptures? How does He fulfill what was written about the Messiah?
3. What is God's salvation plan for all nations? How do you think that the salvation plan for all nations was perceived by the disciples? What had they just been thinking Jesus had come to do?
4. What did the disciples do after the ascension?
