Read Luke 2:22-40

- 1. What Mosaic laws are becoming fulfilled by this presentation (see <u>Lev 12:1-8</u>, <u>Ex 13:2,12,13</u>)? How do these events foreshadow Jesus' mission?
- 2. In Simeon's two prophecies, what was he predicting? What warning does he issue? How is this fulfilled later in the life and ministry of Jesus?
- 3. How does Anna complement Simeon's prophecy?
- 4. What impact would these startling predictions have on all who were listening that day?
- 5. What do you learn about Mary and Joseph in this passage? About Jesus? About God?

Bock states that throughout Luke 1 & 2, "God uses a wide range of people and a vast array of social backgrounds to testify to Jesus: people in a rural setting and people in the city, male and female, a young betrothed couple and a pair of senior citizen saints—all share the joy of his coming."
