Luke 5:1-11



Luke 5:1-11 accounts the calling of the first disciples. Are you a disciple of Jesus? If so, how and when did Jesus first call you to follow Him? When was the first time, if ever, that you responded to Jesus like Peter did in verse 8? If you are not a disciple of Jesus, what is holding you back?

Read Luke 5:1-11

- 1. What does Peter's response in verse 5 teach us about faith?
- 2. How did this miracle affect Peter? What is Peter beginning to grasp about Jesus? About sin? About belief in himself?
- 3. What does this passage teach you about Jesus?

Read John 21:1-14

4. How does this miracle compare and contrast to the fishing miracle described in Luke?



Luke 5:11 states that the disciples left everything to follow Jesus. What is hindering you from following Jesus wholeheartedly? What do you need to leave?

▶ Jesus called Peter to step out in faith and let down his nets for a catch. How is Jesus calling you to step out in faith this week?

▶What would it mean for you to be "catching people" for Jesus?
