## Read Luke 1:46-80

- 1. For what does Mary praise God in her song (vv.46-55)? For what does Zechariah praise God in his song (vv. 67-79)? How do Mary and Zechariah's songs compare and contrast?
- 2. How did John's birth fulfill the words of the angel in vv. 13-17?
- 3. What does it mean that Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit (v. 67)? Is this the same experience with the Spirit that believers experience today? Why or why not?
- 4. What, according to Zechariah's song, is the purpose of salvation? How does his song show God's unfolding plan from OT days to the coming of the Messiah?



In response to what God was doing, Mary and Zechariah erupted in celebration and praise. They recognized God's grace in using them to fulfill his miraculous intervention for Israel. What blessings has God bestowed upon you this Christmas season? How can you praise God for these blessings, as well as your redemption, just as Mary and Zechariah did?
