Psalm 46



► In Psalm 46, the psalmist affirms that God provides His presence, stability, and peace even amidst chaos and destruction. Share of a time when life as you knew it was threatened. How did you respond? What happened?

1. Why does the writer feel immune to disaster (vv. 4-5)? Did Israel prove to be immune?
2. What phrases describe God in this passage?
3. What does it mean that the Lord is Almighty?
4. To whom is “Be still and know that I am God” directed (v. 10)? What do you think it means given the context?

► What difference does it make to you to know Jesus is Lord over all those chaotic events (vv.2-3, 6, 9-10)? How is he a fortress for you? Where do you feel a need for his special protection right now?

► What does it look like for you to “Be still and know that I am God” at this moment in time? Is it easy for you to be still or difficult?
