Romans 8:33-39



▶ Romans 8:37 states, “we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.” Have you felt more like a conqueror or conquered this week?

▶ Describe a time when God reminded you of the love of Christ in the midst of a trial or tribulation.

1. How do verses 31-34 support Romans 8:1, “There is no condemnation for those who are in Christ”?
2. What are the “things” referred to in v. 32? What is promised to those who are in Christ?
3. Of the agents of separation listed in vv. 35-39, which is most threatening to you? To your faith?
4. Why does Paul quote Ps 44:22 in v. 36?
5. What phrase or verse from this passage particularly strikes you and why?

▶ How does being a redeemed son or daughter of God, purchased at a great price, affect the way you *live* your life?
